### **Playing Rules:**

All games are governed by the CAHA, BCAHA and PCAHA rules and regulations.

Any player receiving a Gross Misconduct or Match penalty will be suspended from the tournament.

### Jerseys:

In the event of a jersey colour conflict, the designated home team – first listed in the schedule – will change their jerseys.

### **Round Robin:**

- The competing teams will each play 4 round robin games each.
- Teams will be awarded 2 points for a win, 1 point for a tie and 0 points for a loss.
- All round robin games will have 1.25 hour ice times.
- The 1st period will be **15 minutes in duration**. The 2nd period will be **15 minutes in duration**. The referee will determine the length of the 3rd period at the end of the 2nd period.
- The 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place teams will advance to the playoffs.

### **Round Robin Tie Breaking Procedure:**

- a) Result of tied teams games against each other (for 3 or more tied teams see attached)
- b) Highest positive difference of goals for minus goals against in games between tied teams
- c) Fewest goals against
- d) Lowest penalty minutes
- e) Most goals for
- f) Coin Toss

**NOTE**: All of the playoff games are to be played as a 1.25 hour ice allocation. The extra 15 minutes is for possible OT and shootout if required.





### **Playoff Round:**

1st place team to play 4th place Team 2nd place team to play 3rd place Team

### **Championship Round:**

Bronze Final: 2nd placed teams from playoff round Gold Final: 1st placed teams from playoff round

### Overtime Procedures - Playoff and Championship Rounds:

- There will be a two minute rest between the 3rd period and overtime period.
- Players will remain at their bench.
- One 10-minute, sudden victory period will be played where the first team to score wins the game.
- If no goal is scored, there will be a shoot-out consisting of 3 players from each team.
- If still tied, each team will shoot one for one.
- No player shall shoot twice until everyone has taken a shot.

### **Dispute Resolution:**

Any disputes arising must be presented in writing to the Tournament Coordinator, Rosshi Naiker. The designated Dispute Committee's decision will be final.

### **Dispute Committee:**

Vasilis Pappas, Justine Bourne, Johanna Swanson (\*If any of the above are not available, VP2 (Tournament Coordinator) will appoint a replacement.)





### **Time Outs**

Not permitted during the tournament

### **TIEBREAKER "A" WITH 3 OR MORE TIED TEAMS:**

The results of head to head games between all tied teams whether they played all the tied teams or not.

1.0 for a win

0.5 for a tie, and

-1.0 for a loss.



# TRIBUTE TO HERB HOUSE

1904 - 1980



## Tribute to Herb House

1904-1980

Herb's contributions to the civic, cultural and athletic needs of the City of New Westminster were monumental.

- He was founding member of the New Westminster Minor Hockey Association in 1937
- 1937-1953 he was a coach and referee
- 1938-1956 Bantam Division Manager
- 1954-1978 Treasurer
- 1938-1976 Executive Member
- In 1969 designated as Honorary Executive Life Member



#### Herb's Lifetime Ambition:

"To make wherever I am a better place to live, a better place to work, a better place to play, and also to help everyone near me enjoy life a little better"

Herb was instrumental in organizing the Lower Mainland Minor Hockey Association, the forerunner of the Pacific Coast Amateur Hockey Association of which he was a founding member. He served as the delegate to the British Columbia Amateur Hockey Association (BCAHA) almost continuously from 1947 to 1978. He was a major contributor to the constitution and by-laws for the BCAHA.

- 1952-1959 Herb served as BCAHA Commissioner
- 1954-1958 BCAHA Mutual Aid Fund Secretary Treasurer
- 1959-1978 Director and Chairman of BCAHA Mutual Aid

Herb had received numerous awards for his years of dedicated service to minor hockey.

- Optimist Man of the Year Award
- 1957 BCAHA Diamond Stick Award
- 1960 CAHA Minor Hockey Award
- 1969 Kiwanis Club Annual Award
- 1973 Hockey Canada Annual Award
- 1976 Special New Westminster City Award

Herb was a tireless worker. He served on several Parks and Recreation Committee and was elected as Parks Commissioner from 1955 to 1958.



### Fair Play Code for Parents

- I will not force my child to participate in hockey.
- I will remember that my child plays hockey for his or her enjoyment, not mine.
- I will encourage my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflict without resorting to hostility or violence.
- I will teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of the game.
- I will make my child feel like a winner every time by offering praise for competing fairly and hard.
- I will never ridicule or yell at my child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- I will remember that children learn by example. I will applaud good plays and performances by both my child's team and their opponents.
- I will never question the official's judgment or honesty in public. I recognize officials
  are being developed in the same manner as players.
- I will support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from children's hockey games.
- I will respect and show appreciation for the volunteers who give their time to hockey for my child.

### Fair Play Code for Coaches

- I will be reasonable when scheduling games and practices remembering that young athletes have other interests and obligations.
- I will teach my athletes to play fairly and to respect the rules, officials, opponents and teammates.
- I will ensure all athletes receive equal instruction, discipline, support and appropriate, fair playing time.
- I will not ridicule or yell at my athletes for making mistakes or for performing poorly. I
  will remember that children play to have fun and must be encouraged to have
  confidence in themselves.
- I will make sure that equipment and facilities are safe and match the athlete's ages and ability.
- I will remember that children need a coach they can respect. I will be generous with praise and set a good example.
- I will obtain proper training and continue to upgrade my coaching skills.


